



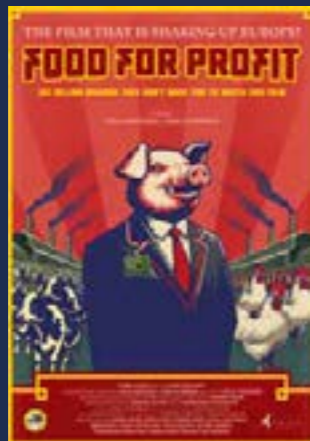

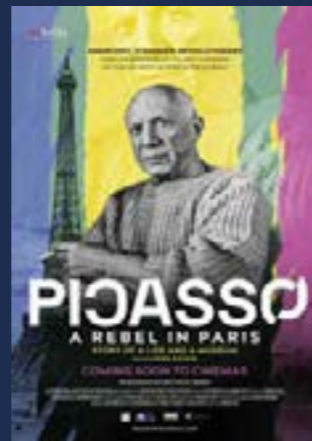

A box office hit in Italy, “Food For Profit” is the first feature documentary that exposes **the links between the meat industry, lobbying, and the corridors of power**. A five-year investigation that denounced how Europe is transferring hundreds of billions of taxpayers’ money into the hands of intensive farms, which mistreat animals, pollute the environment, and pose a potential danger for future pandemics. Three young girls from Calabria compete for the honor of portraying the Madonna in a 500-year-old festival, as a documentary explores their dreams, the town's traditions, and the delicate balance between visibility, faith, and cultural contradictions.

Nicole, Giada, and Mariateresa, three 11-year-old girls from Palmi in Calabria, dream of portraying the Madonna during the Assumption festival (the Varia), a local tradition that has been alive for 500 years. In each edition, a girl is chosen to ascend a sacred 17-meter-high carriage carried on shoulders in a procession. Through their eyes, the documentary explores themes such as physical appearance and the need to be seen, including the voices of the citizens of Palmi and the contradictions of the event that moves between poetry and kitsch, courage and recklessness, present and past.
